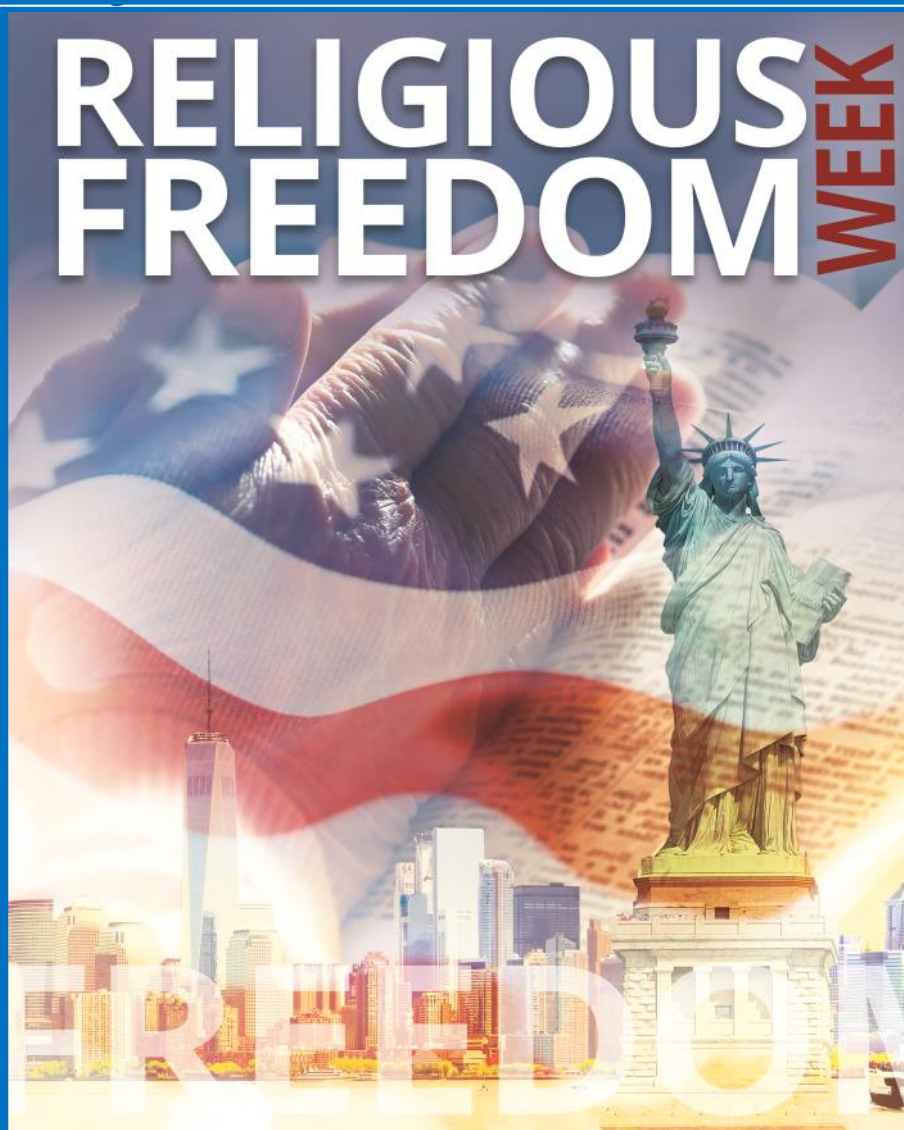

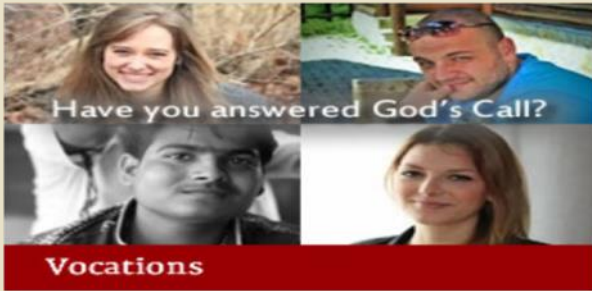

### Parish Appeal Update

As of June 22, a total of **\$341,541.23** in donations has been received and another **\$147,504.94** has been pledged to be paid during the remainder of the campaign's **2-year donation period** – for a total of **\$489,046.17** – 66% of our \$750,000 goal.
