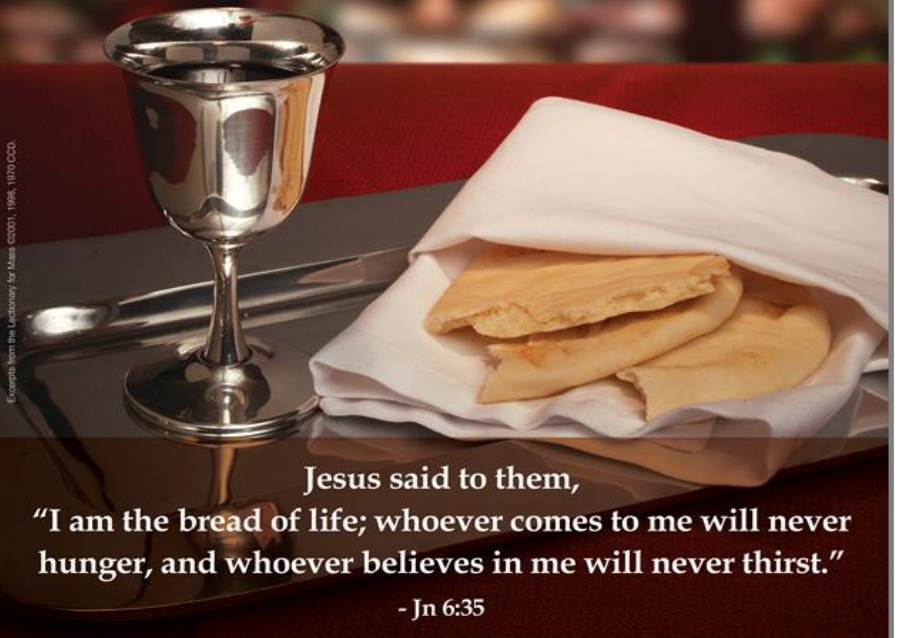

On the weekend of **August 18/19, Fr. Noel Octaviano** from the Missionaries of Jesus, will be visiting for a Parish Mission. He was born in Zarraga, Iloilo in the Philippines. He was a missionary in Brazil for many years and presently works with the Christian-Muslim Dialogue Ministry in the southern part of the Philippines, New Guinea and northern part of Guatemala. In all of these places, he journeys with the poor and tribal minorities pushed by the mainstream society to the far-flung villages. He also works with the immigrants in the USA: in two poor parishes of Los Angeles and on the US and Mexican Border in Brownsville, TX.

In all the parishes where he works, the people cannot finance the sustenance of the missionaries and the different missionary work.

Your generosity makes it possible for these missionaries to bring Christ to the poor.
