

Confessions to Resume at Saint James Church

Publicly scheduled confessions will resume on Saturday, June 27, at 2 p.m. at Saint James Church. The Archdiocese has asked that the traditional confessional not be used at this time and that another area be designated for hearing confessions. Upon arrival at the church, please wait at the entrance of the new addition that faces the parking lot behind the church. A member of the Knights of Columbus will be there to guide you as to when you may go inside. The confessional space, which maintains the six-foot social distancing between the priest and parishioner, is right inside the door. Only one person will be allowed into the confessional space at a time. In addition to maintaining the six-foot social distancing, parishioners are requested to wear a mask while waiting. For your penance, you may make a visit into the church or find another suitable place to fulfill this obligation.
